

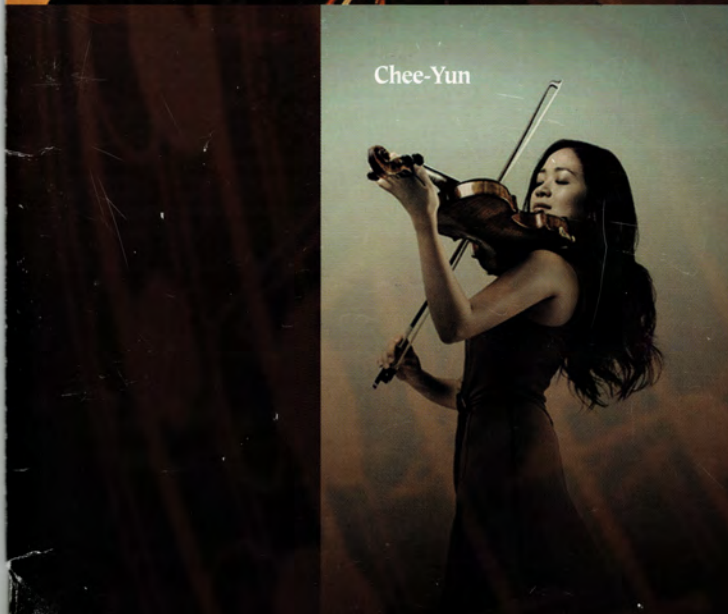

You also will enjoy a cabaret featuring renowned vocalist Sylvia McNair, as well as our first-ever lunchtime concert with Julie and David Coucheron at the charming Café Karibo in downtown Fernandina Beach. In addition, we will offer a series of free community concerts and a performance of the Beth Newdome Resident Festival Artists as part of our educational community outreach.

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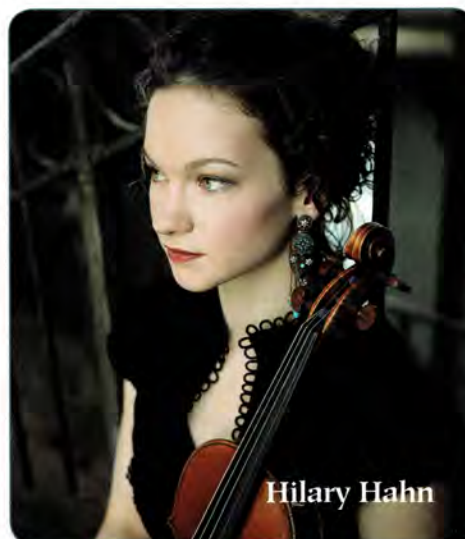

Through their numerous CD releases, radio and television performances, workshops, and collaborative efforts, the Kruger Brothers provide a unique voice in the world of folk, Americana, and classical music. A hallmark of the trio's work is the banjo playing and composition of Jens Kruger, universally considered one of the world's greatest banjoists. Kruger plays in a melodic style that incorporates the three-finger bluegrass style popularized by Snuffy Jenkins and Earl Scruggs. The recording that cemented the Kruger Brothers' sound and song writing, *Up 18 North*, was released in 2002. Most recently, the group's music has ventured into the themes and forms of classical music as exemplified by their 2011 release, *Appalachian Concerto*, which will be performed at this concert.

Although only 32 years old, Hilary Hahn ranks among the greatest violinists performing on the world stage. Her international fame and recognition, including two Grammys, multiple Diapason "d'Or of the Year" and "Preis der deutschen Schallplattenkritik" prizes, and the 2008 Classic FM/ Gramophone Artist of the Year, are a testament to her talent and drive. Ms. Hahn is in constant demand by the world's leading orchestras and regularly performs in the most elite recital series both here and abroad. In the 16 years since she began recording, Ms. Hahn has released 12 feature albums, in addition to three DVDs, an Oscar-nominated movie soundtrack, an award-winning recording for children and various compilations. A recent concerto recording, which paired Schoenberg and Sibelius, brought Hahn her second Grammy: the 2009 Award for Best Instrumental Soloist Performance with Orchestra. Her first Grammy win came in 2003 for her Brahms and Stravinsky concerto album.

Rhapsody in Blue established George Gershwin's reputation as a serious composer and has become one of the most popular of all American concert works. Composed in 1924 for solo piano and jazz band, Rhapsody in Blue combines elements of classical music with jazz-influenced effects. Commissioned by bandleader Paul Whiteman, the piece received its premiere in the concert, An Experiment in Modern Music, on February 12, 1924, in Aeolian Hall, New York with Whiteman and his band and Gershwin playing piano. Our very special performance of Rhapsody in Blue features pianists Julie Coucheron and Elizabeth Pridgen. A native of Oslo, Norway, Ms. Coucheron is an internationally-established musician, winning first prize in all of the national competitions she has attended. Elizabeth Pridgen, the G. Leslie Chair of Music at Mercer University, has distinguished herself as a soloist and chamber musician, having performed at Spivey Hall in Atlanta, the "Rising Stars Series" at the Ravinia Festival, and Alice Tully Hall at Lincoln Center.

conducted the greatest orchestras around the world, also is music director of the Aspen Music Festival and School. Donald Runnicles is general music director of the Deutsche Oper Berlin and chief conductor of the BBC Scottish Symphony Orchestra. Mr. Runnicles is also music director of the Grand Teton Music Festival and principal guest conductor of the ASO. David Coucheron, concertmaster of the ASO, has soloed with many of the world's leading orchestras. Christopher Rex is principal cellist of the ASO.

In 2008 he received the highly coveted Avery Fisher Career Grant, and in 2007 he was one of a handful of participants selected for a Carnegie Hall Professional Training Workshop with Emmanuel Axe and Richard Stoltzman. He was also named that year as one of the "most prominent and emerging soloists" by the American Symphony League Magazine.

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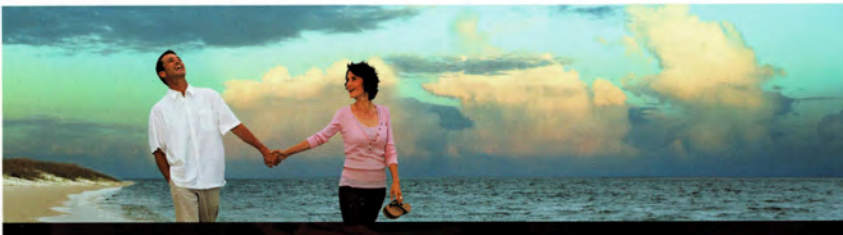

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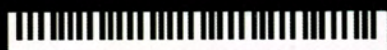
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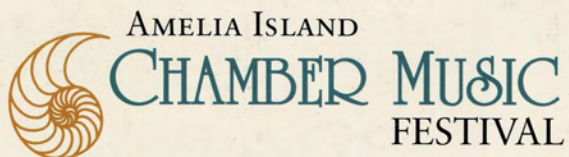
